

Call for Nominations

The Society for Socialist Studies executive calls for nominations to the following positions that fall open or have seen resignations this year:

- President
- Members-at-large (3)

The functions and obligations of these positions are outlined in Section 7 of the constitution at the Society website (<http://socialiststudies.ca/about/constitution/>)

The Society for Socialist Studies executive is also recommending that the following positions be created by constitutional amendment and that we fill them at this meeting if the amendments are passed.

With this in mind, we also call for nominations for the following positions:

- Student and youth representatives (2)
- Scholar-activist representatives (2)
- Membership secretary (1)

The draft functions and obligations of the proposed positions are outlined in the constitutional amendments, located in the draft agenda.

Nominators and nominees for all positions must be paid-up members at the time of nomination. Self-nominations are permitted. Nominators must confirm with those they are nominating that they are willing to stand.

Nominations are permitted in advance by writing to the Society Secretary, Jamie Lawson (societyforsocialiststudies@gmail.com) or from the floor at the meeting.

Advance nominations should come with a short biography of the nominee, including a short statement about relevant experience and skills, and about the nominees' vision for the Society, for advance circulation to the membership.

Elections are by majority vote of the members voting, or (if uncontested) by acclamation. A member of the executive who is not up for election presides over the election process.
